

## Last minute Pre-Wedding Details to Tend to:

- 🍰 Contact your deejay and let him/her know that your reception "schedule of events" should correlate with the amount of reception photography coverage your package includes. For instance, if your package includes one hour of reception time and you want photos of your bouquet toss, make sure your deejay knows that your "schedule" should include that event in the first hour.
- 🍰 Please inform your deejay that your photographer will speak with them upon arrival at your reception to give them an approximate "departure time" so that he/she will be able to keep an eye on the clock and, if necessary, make updates to the "schedule of events". Also, please let your deejay know that it is not acceptable to announce that certain events "must happen now because the photographer has to leave".
- 🍰 Speak with your pastor/minister/reverend. Find out if photography is allowed during the ceremony. Relay this information to us as soon as possible.
- 🍰 If your event includes catering, please make sure to include your photographer(s) in your final meal count. The caterer should be aware that there should be seating assigned for your photographer(s) and that their meal(s) should be served at the same time as the guests, even if they are not at their seat. (Remember- we will be working most of the time, but may like a beverage and bite to eat in between photo opportunities.)
- 🍰 Be sure to let everyone you want in photos with just the bride to be ready at our scheduled start time (90 minutes before your wedding). Anyone who you want in photos with just the groom should be ready 60 minutes prior to the wedding. And don't forget to tell everyone you want in post-wedding photos (photos with both the bride and groom) to stay in the wedding area after the ceremony.
- 🍰 Please don't hesitate to call or email us with any last-minute changes to your wedding plan. We would rather know than not know what's happening!
